Times Tables Rockstars (10 minutes per week). Reading or Grammar (maximum 30 minutes) using LBQ - will be set/due on Mondays. Weekly spellings will be set and tested on Fridays. (These will be stuck into your child's Homework Book). <p>Class Geography Book: One child will come home with this each week to record an information page(s) about a country of their choice from around the world.</p> <p>PE will be on Wednesdays and Thursdays. Children are to come into school in their PE kit on PE days.</p> <p>Please use your child's school/Homework Diary to communicate with us.
